This CD contains the *Willamette Valley-Puget Trough-Georgia Basin* report along with associated maps and appendices. The report, maps and appendices are in Adobe PDF format and can be viewed in most versions of Acrobat Reader. Browse the PDFs:

When reviewing the PDF's you will find all links in blue. These links connect the report with appendices, maps and Web site references. If you travel to a link, you can use your large BACK arrow on the icon menu atop the Acrobat screen to go back to where you left off in the report. Also, the different view options in Acrobat can be used to view pages as a whole or the zoom tool to move into a closer view. The report is formatted for double sided printing. Maps are designed to print on tabloid size sheets.

Browse the Database:

Two databases are included that allow users to interact with the biological and map data used to create this assessment. The **Conservation Planning Tools Database** allows users to query biological data and view data on which this ecoregional assessment was based. Characteristics of the ecoregion, priority conservation areas, targets, and other information is available here. The Conservation Planning Tools Database requires a PC with Microsoft Access 2002 or Microsoft Access 2002 installed.

ArcReader Mapping Tool allows users to work interactively with the map information contained within this ecoregional assessment. The ArcReader Mapping Tool requires ESRI ArcReader be installed first. A copy of ArcReader is available on this CD.
